Obedience entry fees include a \$0.50 AKC Recording Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$4.00 Service Fee for the first entry of a dog, and a \$4.50 Service Fee for each additional Obedience entry of the same dog in the same trial on the same day (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2).

First entry of a dog in **Rally** (per day)..... **\$30.00**
 Each additional entry of the same dog in any **Rally** class (per day) **\$24.00**
If entering both Rally Advanced B and Excellent B, indicate RAE for class Fee: \$54.00

Rally entry fees include a \$4.50 AKC Recording Fee for each entry of a dog (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 4).

ENTRY LIMITS, DAILY:

Obedience and Rally entries are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis with a combined 8-hour judging limit per day.

Entries will be accepted for Dogs listed with AKC Canine Partners and may participate provided their AKC Canine Partners listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

Classes with Jumps will be judged in **Jump Height order**, beginning with the **highest** jump height then **descending**. Handlers with multiple entries in the same jump height will be accommodated.

A limited number of two-day Combination Obedience/Rally Catalogs will be available for purchase (\$10 each) at the trial. *CATALOGS MAY BE ORDERED IN ADVANCE FOR \$5 EACH (see entry form).*

Entry forms without signatures and/or Agreement and Instructions included will not be accepted.

All overnight express mail entries must have the acceptance signature waived. Confirmation of entry and judging program will be sent by Email to the address printed on the entry form. If no Email address is provided, confirmation will be sent via first class USPS mail to the address listed on the Official AKC Entry Form as soon as possible after the closing date as per AKC rules and regulations.

Entry form changes, additions, corrections and cancellations must be received in writing or via Email prior to the closing of entries, be legible, and include the AKC number of dog, or no refunds will be issued. No verbal changes accepted.

Move ups will be accepted as space permits within entry and judging time limits, in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations. Requests for move ups must be made in writing and presented to the Event Secretary no less than 30 minutes before the start of each Trial.

A **Waitlist** will be maintained if the trials fill prior to closing. After closing, withdrawn entries will be replaced with waitlisted ones, if available, and issued a full refund. If no waitlisted entry is able to replace the withdrawn entry, no refund will be given to the withdrawn entry.

Qualifying scores are required for all prizes in Regular Obedience and Rally Obedience Classes. All Special Prizes will be awarded and must be claimed by the conclusion of the Trial. None will be mailed. Winning dog and/or handler must be present or prize will be forfeited. Any unclaimed award will remain with the MAKC. If there are multiple entries of same dog, only the highest score will be eligible for special awards.

Definitions

HS Dog means the dog of either sex with the Highest Qualifying Score in classes indicated.

HTQ Dog means the dog of either sex with the Highest Combined Triple Qualifying Score in classes indicated.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Ring: One 40' x 50' ring with rubber matting over concrete.

Crating: Indoor crating will be available primarily for judges, event secretary, event committee, and stewards. Limited indoor crating space may be available for exhibitors. Watch for information in the final judging program and exhibitor information document. No dogs or crates may be left unattended overnight on the trial grounds. Neither MAKC nor the Event Secretary will be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the site.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for maintaining clean conditions in and around their crates, pens, automobiles and throughout the fair grounds. Please pick up after your dogs. *Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dog will be excused from the trial, with no entry fees refunded.*

Concessions: Food or beverages will not be available for purchase in the trial venue. Many restaurants are located near the trial site and throughout the city of Marshfield, WI.

Lodging: The following area lodging choices accept well-behaved people with their well-behaved pets. Exhibitors must contact lodging choices directly and identify themselves as having dogs. **Be sure to verify the pet policy with your lodging choice when you make your reservation.** Depending on the time of year, RV/motorhome camp sites may be available in the Central Wisconsin State Fair grounds. Entry fees must be included with entry form. Make all Checks and Money Orders payable to the Marshfield Area Kennel Club (MAKC). The Event Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. *Entries without fees will not be accepted.*

All overnight express mail entries must have the acceptance signature waived. Verbal, telephone, FAX, telegraph, and unsigned entries will not be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms or submitted without the AKC entry agreement will not be accepted.

Post-Dated Checks and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Event Secretary will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check.

No Refund For Duplicate Entries. Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries; however, if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Entry Fees Will Not Be Refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, weather or other acts beyond the control of the Event Committee it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entries will be made.

Refunds for Injured Dogs/Bitches In Season. Bitches in season will not be admitted to the Trial and are not permitted to compete. After trial closing, entry fees for bitches in season will be refunded (minus \$5.00/day administration fee) only if notice is received by the Event Secretary 30 minutes prior to the start of judging on the trial date, and entry fees for injured dogs will be refunded (minus \$5.00/day administration fee) only if an invoice from a recent veterinary exam is received by the Event Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging on the trial date.

Errors On Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors made during completion of entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors, or for cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print carefully on entry forms to prevent errors.

Declination of Entries. No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Marshfield Area Kennel Club may decline any entry and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim against the Marshfield Area Kennel Club or any official thereof.

Exhibitors are Responsible for the Behavior of Their Dogs and/or Children. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise area. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

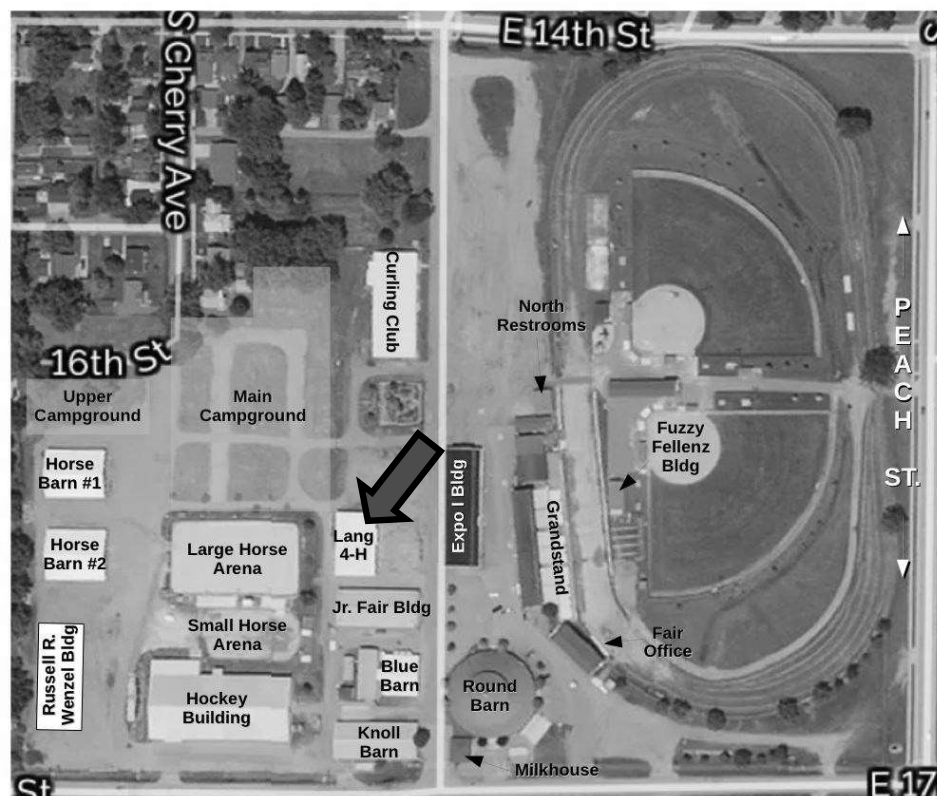
DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From North, South and East: Take I-39 to Hwy 10 West toward Marshfield. Continue on Hwy 10 West for approximately 28 miles to Business WI-13 North. At the traffic circle, follow signs for Business WI-13 North (Central Ave). Follow Central Ave North to South Maple Ave (slight right). Follow S. Maple Ave to E. 17th St. Turn right onto E. 17th St and proceed 2 blocks to the Central Wisconsin State Fair Grounds. Turn left at the Round Barn and proceed to the parking area. The Lang 4-H building is in the center of the fair grounds.

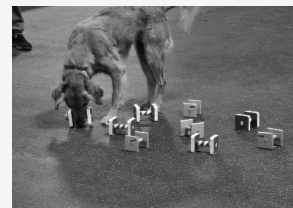
From West: Take Hwy 29 East toward Green Bay. Take Exit 132 for WI-13 South toward Colby/Abbotsford. Follow WI-13 South for approximately 21 miles. In Marshfield, turn Right onto S. Central Ave and continue to E. 14th St. Turn left onto E. 14th St. In one block, turn right onto S. Maple Ave. Continue 3 blocks to E. 17th St. Turn left onto E. 17th St and proceed 2 blocks to the Central Wisconsin State Fair Grounds. Turn left at the Round Barn and proceed to the parking area.
